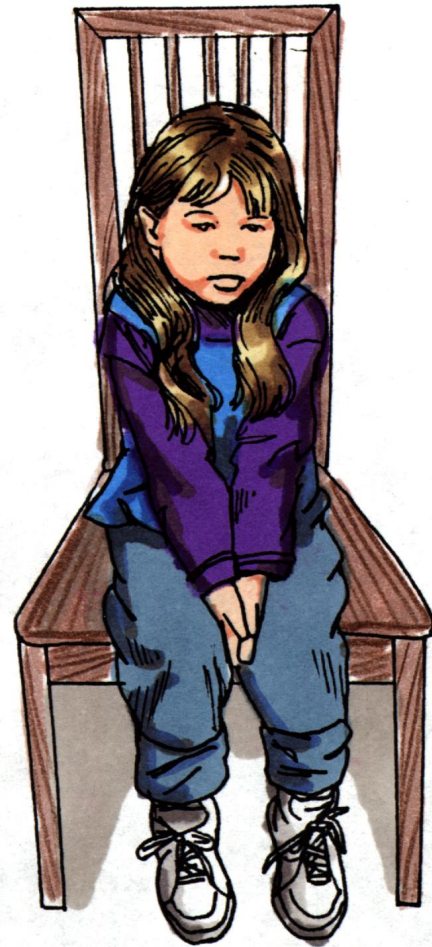
Regina M. Kupecky, LSW

Completely truthful disclosures help the child to heal and grow



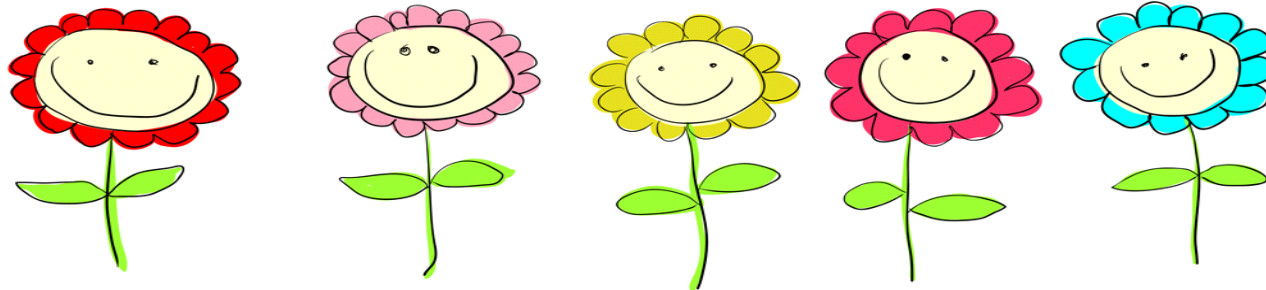
- ▶ Angry parents will help keep the mean child mean, the wild child wild, the scared child scared, and the hurt child hurt
