MEETING YOUR NEWBORN

Appeal to your baby's sense

Avoid excessive eye contact

Leave the room as little as possible



Snuggle up

Be Patient with yourself, your spouse and your infant

Know your doctor before hand.

Feeding and Burping Baby

Your Baby is getting enough nutrition when:



- Steady weight gain
- Regular soft stools
- 6-8 wet diapers per day
- Seems generally happy and content especially when feeding



Breast Feeding



Via Lactation Induction

<u>Flimination, Diapering, and Bottom</u>L





- Disposable vs. Cloth
- Keep Baby clean and dry
- Diaper rash cream and/or Baby Powder
- Avoid covering the umbilical cord and care
- Circumcision Care
- Pseudo Menses





Reasons to call your Doctor

- * Temperature : (98.6 is normal, but may vary in each child) Red, flushed appearance, irritable and listless
- ★ Diarrhea: Watery stools with mucus, with vomiting, not hungry or reluctant to feed
- ★ Vomiting: Excessive, persistent or forceful
- * Not feeling well: Noticeable changes in feeding pattern and listlessness
- * Skin Rashes: Red rashes, oozing or crusted sores, blisters, and severe diaper rash
- * Yellow Skin: Prolonged Jaundice after leaving the hospital

Bathing Your Baby



- warm Room
- Water Temperature
- Baby Safety
- From Head to Toe Clean to Dirty -Every Fold, nook, and cranny
- Soap
- Drying and Temperature Regulation NEVER LEAVE BABY UNATTENDED

CRANKY, CRYING BABY

Why is my baby crying?

- Hungry
- In Pain
- Want to be held
- Tired
- Sucking Self Soothing
- Wants stimulation
- Over stimulation
- Diaper change needed
- Too Hot
- Too Cold
- Need to be Burped or Gassy
- COLIC



Preventing SIDS

★ Firm Mattress and fitted sheet

★ Baby should NEVER sleep in your bed

★ Clear crib of clutter

★ Minimal blankets

★ Do not let baby over heat at night
