

What is an adoption portfolio/ profile?



{Portfolio samples included in HOW TO CREATE A SUCCESSFUL ADOPTION PORTFOLIO}

- great photos that SHOW something about you and the life you hope to share

What do you need?



- meaningful, honest, authentic text



- a way to create the profile/portfolio

deciding what sections/pages to include

- look closely at your agency / attorney guidelines

- think about the things that make up your life and the things you are excited to share with the child you hope to welcome into your family

- remember pages can be everything from home & extended family pages to Disney trip pages and sections for Disney die-hards. Make it YOU!

- check out an extensive list of section examples and how they apply to you in my book, **HOW TO CREATE A SUCCESSFUL ADOPTION PORTFOLIO**

You are the expert! No one knows you and all you hope to share with a child better than you do!



"Do's" when Choosing photos - choose a great, real photo for your cover- it

- choose a great, real photo for your cover-IS your 1st "hello, nice to meet you"

- choose pictures that show something about you

- choose pictures that evoke a feeling or emotion

- if you do not have pictures of things you do often or hope to share with a child then go take some!

"Don'ts" when Choosing photos

- avoid using too many pictures with sunglasses

- avoid too many head and shoulder shots that are showing nothing about you

- avoid being someone you are not in an effort to impress

- avoid getting lazy and just throwing things on the page because you already have them

Things to remember when writing your portfolio text



HONEST, ETHICAL PROFILE **CREATION** is important-"Because your adoption portfolio/adoption profile should show you, with the love and honesty that you and the expectant parents reading it, deserve!" - madeleine melcher

HONEST, ETHICAL PROFILE CREATION is important-

"You have to be YOU. You ARE good enough and will be exactly what someone is looking for. If you are not yourself in your profile, you do yourself and all who read it an injustice and begin things with a lie. If we are to make matches with families that REALLY want the same things (which is SO IMPORTANT) then this part is key."




